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If yes, can you measure the drop in emotional mass?

Have you ever been inspired and felt your energy rise?

If yes, can you mark the voltage on your soul?

Have you ever watched chaos fall into order and called it beautiful?

If yes, can you compute the algorithm of awe?

Do you believe love changes things, even if you can't prove how?

If yes, congratulations—your heart just validated the hidden half of the lattice.
